foreword from the chair and chief executive

The cohealth Board of Directors and Executive Leadership Team are proud to make available the first Strategic Plan for cohealth. This plan is based on an extensive consultation process with the community, staff and the wider health sector, and reflects many things you would expect from a rights-based community health organisation: better health outcomes; nurturing diversity; a strong and values-based workforce; and empowering people to be involved in co-designing the services that they use.

Our plan also contains some bold ideas about the future health care system that the cohealth Board would like to see, cohealth needs to be contemporary, bold, progressive and evidence-based. We must not just be a provider of quality health care, but play our part in building a better, more responsive, more costeffective health system. We must help to meet the challenges facing Australia's primary health care sector. These challenges include funding mis-matches, vast systemic changes brought by the National Disability Insurance Scheme, and a shift in the community towards complex, long-term and chronic physical and mental health conditions.

We want to be welcoming; to advocate for what is right; to be a good partner; and to be a good neighbour. We want to care about all the things that impact on the wellbeing of people – but our focus is on health equity. We recognise that the people we serve face barriers to good health throughout the whole of their lives: low income; poor infrastructure; low health literacy; and lack an understanding of our complex health system.

Addressing these barriers and responding with a proactive and integrated service, will improve people's ability to manage their own health, and reduce the cost to the public health system.

But a plan is only as good as its implementation. Our goal over the next three years is to work hard together with you, the people we deliver services to or partner with, and our staff, to provide a welcoming, engaged and integrated community health service.

about this strategic plan

The inaugural cohealth strategic plan 2015–18 focuses our efforts on supporting people with the greatest need and the poorest health. It captures who we are today, but it also describes our vision and intentions for the future.

cohealth is a large community organisation of more than 850 staff, delivering health services from over 40 sites across 14 local government areas in northern and western metropolitan Melbourne. We also conduct statewide programs that improve community and individual health and wellbeing.

Each year we deliver almost half a million medical, dental, mental health, allied health, and community support services to over 110,000 people. At the core of these services are principles of human rights, codesign and a social model of health.

We understand that an ageing population and workforce, rising chronic disease, a revolution in information and technology, and changing user expectations mean we must adjust and evolve.



We welcome and celebrate diversity in all its forms. We recognise that by working in partnership with people, consumers, clients and carers we create many opportunities for participation and innovation. By working together we create a stronger voice in public debates that can be a catalyst for health equity and system reform.

The people who access our services come from marginalised communities, face multiple health disadvantages and are frequently at risk of falling through gaps in health systems and funding.

The plan was developed with input from over 550 staff, partners and many of the people that use our services. We hope it gives expression to their dreams for a vibrant, diverse, innovative, enduring and caring community health service that remains deeply arounded in local community.

This strategic plan represents the direction cohealth will take towards our vision of healthy communities, healthy people. We will focus on improving the health and wellbeing of the people and the communities we work with, involving them in service design, development and delivery. We will be a strong voice for the rights of people to access health care. Our workforce will be diverse, welcoming and innovative, our organisation progressive and enduring.


